Our Dear Prayer Supporter,

**T**he Apostle Paul wrote: *I have nothing to glory of; for necessity is laid upon me; yea, woe is me if I preach not the Gospel* 1 CORINTHIANS 8:16.

As a lad, my parents took me to London for the Coronation of the late King George VI. We were allocated a position outside Buckingham Palace where we could view the regal spectacle of the royal procession as it passed to and from Westminster Abbey. As soon as the event was over and we tried to make our way home, our family became part of a congested throng of humanity who at the same time tried to enter the restricted entrance into London's Underground Railway! The dense crowd pressed on every side and I found that I could lift my legs off the ground and still be propelled. Excitedly I said to my mother: "Look! I'm moving without even walking!" Necessity was laid upon me!

Such was the case with the Apostle Paul, when, in relation to his pioneer missionary ministry, he proclaimed: "*Necessity is laid upon me!*" It was also true of the Apostle Peter when the Lord Jesus said to him: "*When thou shalt be old . . . another shall gird thee: and carry thee where thou wouldst not go*" JOHN 5:8.

And so it was when, in the mid-seventies, Dorothy and I felt constrained to make our first missionary journey to Mombasa, Kenya. Subsequent decades of making Gospel tools available to Kenyan nationals, the Lord has increasingly opened doors for consolidation and expansion of CCIM's ministry by cooperative fellowship with TWR Kenya.

Thus, CCIM's expanding outreach in Kenya includes distribution of Bibles; "missionaries in paper covers"; broadcasts; and other encouragements for TWR's bold Gospel expansion into unreached areas through radio. It is a real step of faith and obedience each time money and materials are sent for this cooperative fellowship. In these perilous days you are a vital part of this ministry. Thank you! *Yea, woe is me if I preach not the Gospel.*

**First Bible container for Kenya!**

We are most grateful for the cooperative fellowship of Pastor Chuck and Kay Smith who initiated the Bible and container projects to assist TWR Kenya meet the urgent spiritual need of Kenyans. In the first consignment of the Bibles, over 500 selected Pastors participated in the careful and prayerful distribution to members of their congregation who had never possessed a Bible of their own. Now we prayerfully anticipate that the second and third containers of Bibles will likewise bring spiritual enlightenment to those who thirst for the Word of God.

Not only the Bibles were sent, but each of the three 20-foot containers will be a vital part of the ongoing TWR missionary radio outreach. Accordingly, please pray for the new FM Sifa radio sites which are located in strategic places to bring the Gospel into regions beyond.

## **Praise the Lord! 75,259 English Bibles sent to Kenya in three Containers!**

**1st container** arrived at Mombasa on Dec. 23rd, 2008, with 27,000 used and new Bibles. Container now utilized in **Nairobi** as a distribution book storage facility.

**2nd container** arrived at Mombasa June 29, 2010, with 25,259 used and new Bibles. Container will be utilized in **Voi** for housing an FM radio station!

**3rd container** to arrive at Mombasa August 15, 2010, with 23,000 new and used Bibles. Container possibly will be utilized at **Lamu** for housing another FM radio station.

**Last year, CCIM sent a small generator for the TWR FM radio station in Garissa.**



Praise God, because of your fellowship, CCIM was able to help purchase the new TWR Nairobi

45KVa Generator equipment. This generator is truly an answer to prayer as Kenya experienced months of intense drought. Less water meant a constant cut in the generation of hydro-electric power which resulted in a nation-wide electricity rationing schedule of up to 35 hours of electricity a week. Now the broadcasts are aired without interruption and are being streamlined to the seven FM stations—this includes "Dorothy's Daily Devotional."
