Dear Prayer Supporter,

It's not about "Politics." It's not about "the Bennett's." It is all about **JESUS!** The Lord Jesus of whom the Apostle John wrote: "*Jesus Christ the righteous: And He is the propitiation [the atoning Sacrifice] for our sins: and not for our's only, but also for the sins of the whole world*" 1 John 2:1, 2. So it is, in vast areas of the whole world, by means of: "*missionaries in paper covers;*" missionary radio and Google Ads, that CCIM relentlessly continues to extend the Gospel message as expressed in the hymn of Charles Wesley (1707-88):

Jesus! The name high over all, in hell, or earth, or sky;
Angels and men before it fall, and devils fear and fly.
His only righteousness I show, His saving grace proclaim;
'Tis all my business here below to cry: "Behold the Lamb!
Happy, if with my latest breath I might but gasp His name;
Preach Him to all, and cry in death: "Behold, behold the Lamb!

Many years ago the late Dr. Alan Redpath commented on "*Your Quest for God*": "This is the very best book of its kind I have ever read. It not only makes the Gospel clear to unbelievers but it also keeps us all on track. May "*Your Quest for God*" have the wide circulation it so truly deserves!" At that time, neither Alan nor ourselves could conceive just how far and wide the readership of "*Quest*" would become. For example, just today we heard from a Pastor friend in South Africa:

"I plan on including a link to the Linguablast downloads of your books on the church website when I redo the site in a couple of weeks. However, I do still have some copies in English, Afrikaans and in Zulu. I have to admit, though, that while for some the downloadable version of the books works very well, there is nothing like, when in a counseling session at the church, being able to give someone who has no internet access a hard copy of the book and see them come back the next week all excited about what they have read. And when you look at the book you gave them you see that they have highlighted sections of it!

"I strongly recommend that you do not totally abandon the idea of printing books in these languages, but that you may continue doing a combination of both. In countries here in Africa, internet is very, very expensive. Just to use an internet Café for 30 minutes can cost people that earn less than a dollar a day more than a week's earnings. The tragedy is that I am now dealing with a situation right here in Johannesburg where people with skills and qualifications – internet people, boiler makers, welders – people with trades and degrees behind their names are sleeping in the streets. Sitting behind me now in my office is Tumiso. Tumiso is an internet qualified professional I found begging for money at a traffic light. He is a Christian young man – very polite and honest – but he cannot find employment. I have brought him in to help me. So, the situation with the Global Economic crises is really bad for so many people. There are so many people out there in Johannesburg, the rest of the country and, indeed, the rest of Africa that struggle to put even the most basic of meals on the table. As a result I have placed four copies of "*Your Quest for God*" and "*Food for Faith*" in the languages they have been published in, into the church library for the various members and regular visitors to the church to take out. At least now this helps a little as many of the congregants are poor."

So, with this heart-rending letter, Dorothy and I face another dilemma. While the open door for CCIM to reach people in desolate and spiritually barren regions of the world grows exponentially, the giving constituency diminishes as many supporters have been called Home! When facing financial crises, Hudson Taylor said: "*Ask the Lord and tell His people!*" Thank you for your prayerful involvement and help in the blessed name of **Jesus!**
