
study of prophecy is exciting, but if it is not accompanied by a renewed passion to reach the lost and committed to biblical intercession, it is of little eternal value.

“Dorothy’s Daily Devotionals” continue to be broadcast over KBC five days a week in Kenya. These popular programs also are aired by FM TWR broadcasts from Marsabit, Garissa, Lodwar, Lamu, and Voi. Please note orange circle near the Coast.

TWR Voi broadcast from Vuria Hill where a 45-meter mast has been erected to facilitate transmission to listeners all over the Coast Province; in parts of Eastern Province; and in the northern parts of Tanzania. Frequent power outages have been a severe challenge and necessitated the purchase of a large generator.

CCIM, on your behalf, has responded to the urgent need of a 15KVA generator for Vuria Hill which is the highest place in Kenya’s Coast Province. The signal will be heard in the northern part of Tanzania and regions bordering Kenya and Mombasa. Gospel messages transmitted from Voi will reach many people of another religion.

We count on the Lord’s provision through such friends as you for the expensive outreach of CCIM broadcasts over both Kenya Broadcasting Corporation & the translation/production and airing of “Dorothy’s Daily Devotionals” in other languages over TWR.
