Hungarian copies of "Your Quest for God."

You might remember that in previous years CCIM printed and distributed, without cost to the recipient, thousands of copies of Hungarian "YQFG" and "*Food for Faith*," which were placed in hospitals, in prisons and in the hands of teachers to use in their classrooms. However, they have practically ran out of "YQFG" as there is a constant demand for these books to be available for these and other ministries. There are 3-4 million Hungarian people living in post-communist countries and these books are a vital "*tool for evangelism*" of which 3,000 copies alone are immediately requested for continued ministry in the prisons. Through your gifts to CCIM, a further \$4,500 has just been wired to Budapest, Hungary, to make this printing possible. Please pray that each Hungarian copy of "YQFG" will strategically reach people who will receive the Lord.

Israel: Russian copies of "Your Quest for God."

Over the years, CCIM has had the privilege of sponsoring through, "Keren Ahvah Meshihit" in translating and distributing "YQFG" and "FFF" in the Hebrew, Arabic and Russian languages. Interestingly, over one million people in Israel speak Russian and gladly receive CCIM books! Recently, we were asked to again replenish the empty shelves of the Russian copies of "YQFG." Through your financial assistance, a further \$7,000 was wired to "KAM" to make this possible. Please back-up this spiritual investment with your prayers for these precious people.
